JANIE RODRIGUEZ AWARD

Selection Criteria

Each year the Village of Lake Odessa presents an award to an outstanding citizen and community volunteer, entitled the “Janie Rodriguez Award.” The award will be based on the community service or volunteer activities or projects that have a significant impact on the Lake Odessa area and community, as well as activities which exemplify and honor the way in which Janie Rodriguez lived her life. The activities or projects should reflect consistent, continued engagement over a period of time.

Selection Criteria:

1. from the Lakewood Area (Lake Odessa, Sunfield, Woodland, Clarksville);
2. be nominated by an individual or group; nominations must contain brief biographical information that identifies why and how the individual being nominated exemplifies the spirit and manner in which Janie Rodriguez lived her life.
3. be an individual who honors and values the things that Janie Rodriguez held dear including family, friends, faith and community;
4. be an individual who is caring, giving, loving and community minded who often places the needs of others in front of their own needs;
5. be an individual who goes above and beyond the call of duty in the spirit of giving.

The award recipient will receive a plaque as a keepsake, commemorating this honor. His or her name will be engraved on a permanent plaque which will hang in the Page Memorial Building. The winner will also serve on the Janie Rodriguez Committee to take part in the selection process of future award winners.
