**Articles We'll Take:**

- ♥ Household furniture & lawn furniture
- ♥ Lawn mowers (drain oil & gasoline)
- ♥ BBQ grills;
- ♥ Bicycles;
- ♥ Bath tubs & sinks;
- ♥ Building materials, but see below;
- ♥ Recyclable metals;
- ♥ Household appliances, certified freon-free;
- ♥ Misc. household trash, but see below;
- ♥ Other stuff kind of like this stuff.

**Articles We Won't Take:**

- ⊗ Tires;
- ⊗ Cement, stones, bricks, patio blocks, etc.;
- ⊗ Roofing shingles;
- ⊗ Yard waste; e.g., leaves, brush, grass clippings;
- ⊗ Household garbage;
- ⊗ Animal waste;
- ⊗ Liquids & chemicals; e.g., paint, oils, pesticides;
- ⊗ Fire extinguishers;
- ⊗ Debris containing hazardous substances;
- ⊗ Electronic devices & batteries;
- ⊗ Other stuff kind of like this stuff.



**DISPOSAL CHARGES:**

For many years, the Village of Lake Odessa has been pleased to offer the spring clean-up service at no cost to its residents. Disposal costs have risen dramatically however, so we need to charge for some items.

**Couches, Loveseats, Upholstered Chairs,  
Mattresses, Box Springs, etc:  
Disposal Charge - \$35 Per Individual Item**

This charge applies to residents and non-residents alike.

**Additional Non-Resident Service Charge:  
Disposal Charge - \$50 Per Trip**

**HOW TO PAY:**

Cash or checks will be accepted at the Public Works Garage during the event.
